

## RÈGLEMENT

**ARTICLE 1. DATES**

The first edition of the TAKAVOIR Festival will take place in Niort on May 8th 2010.

**ARTICLE 2. ORGANISATION**

**ARTICLE 3. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

Participation in the TAKAVOIR Festival is open exclusively to films created with mobile phone and/or digital cameras that fit in your hand.

The length and type of film is open. The Theme for the first edition is "TREE".

Films can be edited inside or outside the mobile phone or non-edited.

Participation is free-of-charge.

**ARTICLE 4. REGISTRATION FOR PRESELECTION**

Registration for the TAKAVOIR Festival will be done exclusively via the website [www.takavoit.fr](http://www.takavoit.fr) A registration form must be fully completed for each film submitted to the festival. The film-makers will have to indicate the link to their films.

To validate a submission the participants must fill out **the registration** form in full and send the required materials – a CD or DVD (any format) containing :

- The film
  - Three photos of the film

We also invite film-makers to send us their pictures.

**The deadline for registering a film (i.e., the date at which the reception of a copy of the film on CD or DVD must be received at the office of hORS cHAMPS) is April 15th, 2010.**

**ARTICLE 5. SELECTION**

The selection committee of the TAKAVOIR Festival will choose from among the films submitted, those to be selected to take part in the competition.

Confirmation of reception of their film will be sent to participants by e-mail and this will validate their registration.

Selected film-makers will be advised of their selection before the festival opens.

**ARTICLE 6. PROMOTION**

For the purpose of promoting this edition of the TAKAVOIR festival and for the next two editions to come, hORS cHAMPS will be free ( participants authorized hORS cHAMPS ) to diffuse the names, address, and pictures of the participants and any extract of the selected films to all print media, television, Internet and/or Wap sites, and to the public by any electronic means of communication.

**ARTICLE 7. DIFFUSION OF FILMS****Before the TAKAVOIR festival**

Preselected films will be broadcast on the [www.takavoit.fr](http://www.takavoit.fr) website and on all the other partners' websites. The film-makers taking part give permission for these broadcasts free of charge.

**During the festival**

The selected films will be shown on the [www.takavoit.fr](http://www.takavoit.fr) website during the festival, and throughout the manifestation.

**After the festival**

For the purpose of promoting and valorising the films on a non commercial basis, hORS cHAMPS is authorized to diffuse the films, for three years from the date of reception of the film by the festival organisers on all partners' websites

The film-makers who take part in the festival grant these permissions free of charge, and consent, for a period of THREE YEARS to refrain from giving the rights to show their films.

For the purposes of the screenings mentioned above, hORS cHAMPS may copy and adapt the films exclusively for reasons related to the ergonomic, technical and graphic constraints of receiving terminals.

All participating film-makers declare themselves to be the legal owners of all rights relating to the copying, representation and diffusion of their films. HORS cHAMPS informs all film-makers that the use of pre-existing works of music in films requires written permission from the copyright owners.

The film-maker consents to the diffusion of his/her film according to the conditions defined within

the Creative Commons licence "Non-commercial Attribution 2.0 France" in order to better serve the non-commercial diffusion of his/her work. The complete licence can be found at : (<http://creativecommons.org/licenses/by-nc-sa/2.0/fr/>)

Film-makers will be personally liable in case of complaints ensuing from the diffusion of their films by hORS cHAMPS and will guarantee hORS cHAMPS against any loss or damage the Association may sustain.

**ARTICLE 8. AWARDS**

A jury made up of professionals from the world of the cinema will award the following prizes

- Le Grand Prix du Festival > 1.000 €
  - Le Prix de la Ville de Niort > 500 €
  - Le Prix de la Citoyenneté / SMACL Assurances > 500 €
  - Le Prix du Public > 150 €
- The public will be able to vote for a film during the Festival

**ARTICLE 9. ORGANISER'S RESPONSIBILITIES**

TAKAVOIR Festival reserves the right to use the information in the registration forms under

the conditions specified in law 78.17 of January 6th, 1978. In accordance with "la loi Informatique et Libertés" (French law on data protection). Entrants are given a right of access and rectification concerning data in which their names appear. By contacting hORS cHAMPS

The Pocket Films Festival declines all liability relating to the reception or non-reception, for whatever reason, of registration files or films.

HORS cHAMPS reserves the right to interrupt, suppress or postpone the event at any time, according to its operating requirements. Entering the TAKAVOIR Festival implies acceptance of the present regulations.

**ARTICLE 10. MODIFICATION, CANCELLATION**

hORS cHAMPS reserves the right to shorten, modify or cancel the Festival, or to change its content, either if exceptional circumstances, or circumstances beyond the association's control, so require, or to ensure the safety, equity, integrity or proper functioning of the festival.

HORS cHAMPS shall not be in any way liable in any of the above cases.  
No compensation of any kind will be due to entrants.

**ARTICLE 11. ADHERING THE FESTIVAL**

Entering the TAKAVOIR festival implies the acceptance of the present regulations which can be consulted and downloaded on the TAKAVOIR Festival website.

Any disagreement about the interpretation or application of the present regulations will be submitted to the appreciation of hORS cHAMPS without prejudice or appeal to the Tribunal de Grande Instance de Niort .
